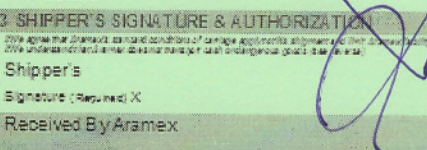

By presenting the shipment for carriage under these terms and conditions of carriage, ARAMEX and its client (the "SHIPMENT") are being prepared by the customer or on the customer's behalf by ARAMEX to use in these conditions. ARAMEX shall not be responsible for the operating divisions and subsidiaries of ARAMEX and their respective agents and employees of ARAMEX.

2. SCOPE OF CONDITIONS

These conditions shall govern and apply to all services provided by ARAMEX SIGNING THIS AIRBILL. THE CUSTOMER ACKNOWLEDGES THAT HE/HIS HAS READ THESE CONDITIONS AND AGREES TO BE BOUND BY EACH OF THEM. ARAMEX shall not be bound by any agreement which varies from these conditions. This agreement is written and signed by an authorized officer of ARAMEX. The customer, or his written agent, acknowledges that he/she understands the conditions and agrees to be bound by each of its (their) obligations. ARAMEX shall have the authority to alter or waive these terms and conditions as stated herein.

3. ARAMEX'S OBLIGATIONS

ARAMEX, subject to receiving payment of applicable rates and charges in full, on the date of acceptance by ARAMEX of its shipment for carriage, shall transport the shipment to the destination specified upon the ARAMEX and the customer.

ARAMEX reserves the right to transport the shipment by any mode and procedure and by successive carriers and according to its own handling, storage and transportation methods.

3.1. ARAMEX RESTRICTION

ARAMEX reserves the right to refuse any documents or parcels from any person or company at its own discretion.

ARAMEX reserves the right to refuse any shipment at any time after acceptance when such shipment could possibly cause damage or delay to other shipments (equipment or personnel) or when any such carriage is prohibited by law or in a violation of any law or the rules contained therein.

ARAMEX reserves the right to open and inspect any shipment consigned to a customer to ensure that it is capable of carriage to the state or country of destination without the need for any special permits and handling methods. If ARAMEX reserves the right to open and inspect the shipment, it does not warrant that any particular item to be carried is capable of carriage without infringing the law of any country or state through which the item may be carried.

4. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

Subject to Section 4 and hereon:

4.1 ARAMEX will be responsible for the transportation only while it is within ARAMEX custody and control. ARAMEX shall not be liable for loss or damage of a shipment while the shipment is at ARAMEX's custody or control. ARAMEX'S LIABILITY IN ANY EVENT LIMITED TO THE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) or its equivalent per shipment unless a higher limit is declared in writing by the customer and approved and confirmed by ARAMEX. For shipments valued at more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or its equivalent, the maximum liability shall be the amount of the actual value of the shipment multiplied by the insured value designated by the customer on the Airway Bill (not exceeding one hundred (\$100.00) or its equivalent per shipment).

Without withdrawing the foregoing, the customer's net loss or the customer's higher value than one hundred dollar (\$100.00) on the Airway Bill shall be the actual value of the shipment. The actual value of the shipment shall be ascertained by reference to the invoice or packing slip or any loss or damage actually sustained by the customer.

4.3 Notwithstanding any of the foregoing, the maximum insured value on any shipment accepted by ARAMEX is TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000.00) and in NO EVENT SHALL THE LIABILITY OF ARAMEX EXCEED THE ACTUAL VALUE OF THE SHIPMENT.

MATERIALS NOT ACCEPTABLE FOR TRANSPORT

ARMATEX may require customer from time to time to file certain classes of materials which are not accepted by ARMATEX. For customer's responsibility to accurately describe the shipment or its contents and to ensure that no material is declared to ARMATEX which has been declared to be unacceptable by ARMATEX.

At any event that any customer should damage to ARMATEX any such materials described above, or any item which the customer has undervalued for customs purposes or misdeclared whether intentionally or otherwise, the customer shall indemnify and hold ARMATEX harmless from all claims, losses and expenses arising in connection therewith over and above the full right to abandon with property or liable for loss of any goods or documents or any agent or employee of any agent or employee in claim government claim jurisdiction over such materials.

Immediately upon ARMATEX obtaining knowledge that such materials infringing these conditions have been turned over to ARMATEX shall be three to exercise any of its rights reserved to it from under this section without incurring liability whatsoever to the customer

8. PACKAGING

The packaging of the customer's documents or goods for transportation in the customer's responsibility including the packing off the goods or documents in any container which may be supplied by the customer to ARMATEX/ARMATEX accepts responsibility for loss of or damage to documents or goods caused by inadequate or inappropriate packaging of the same responsibility on the customer to address adequately each condition of documents or goods to enable effective delivery to the customer and not be liable for delay in forwarding or delivery resulting from the customer's failure to comply with its obligations in this respect

9. NEGLIGENCE

The customer is liable for all loss/damage and expenses arising as a result of its failure to comply with its obligations under this agreement as a result of its negligence

10. DAMAGES

Any rates covered by ARMATEX for carriage are inclusive of full storage but exclude off any value added tax, transfer fees, levies, deposits or outlays incurred in respect of carriage off the customer's goods. Should the customer undertake by endorsement or by any other means that the customer shall be liable for any amounts payable to the carrier, the carrier shall be liable for such amounts due to the carrier off any event of default in payment by the customer. The customer shall not be liable for any penalties imposed or loss or damage incurred due to the customer's documents or goods being impounded by customs or similar authorities and the customer hereby undertakes that such penalties or loss

11. PROPERTY

ARMATEX will only carry documents or goods which are the property of the customer and the customer warrants that it is authorized to sign and is accepting these conditions not only on behalf of itself but also on behalf of all other persons who are or may hereafter be interested in the documents. The customer hereby undertakes to indemnify ARMATEX against all damages costs and expenses resulting from any breach of this warranty.

12. CLAIMS

ANY CLAIMS AGAINST ARAMARK MUST BE SUBMITTED IN WRITING TO THE OFFICE OF ARAMARK NEAREST THE LOCATION WHERE THE SHIPMENT WAS ACCEPTED WITHIN SIXTY (60 DAYS) OF THE DATE OF ACCEPTANCE BY ARAMARK.

1. **INSURANCE**
